

OMEPRAZOLE

- Form:** 40mg vial as dry powder
- Reconstitution:** Add 5ml of glucose 5% or sodium chloride 0.9% to each vial. Further dilution is then needed.
Use sodium chloride 0.9% reconstituted vials within 12 hours.
Use glucose 5% reconstituted vials within 3 hours.
- Administration:**
- a) IV infusion (intermittent)
 - b) IV infusion (continuous)
 - c) IV bolus
- Method:**
- a) Add reconstituted solution to 100ml of compatible infusion fluid and administer over 20 to 30 minutes.
 - b) After initial bolus, add reconstituted solution to 100ml of compatible fluid, and administer at a rate of 8mg per hour.
 - c) Administer reconstituted vial over 5 minutes.
- Compatibility & Stability:**
- Sodium Chloride 0.9%
Glucose 5%
NOTE: Reconstituted solution is stable in Glucose 5% for three hours only, and for 12 hours in Sodium Chloride 0.9%.
