

STREPTOKINASE

- Form:** 1 500 000 unit vial
(Streptase™)
- Reconstitution:** Add 5ml sodium chloride 0.9% to the vial, directing the diluent against the sides of the vial rather than the drug powder. Roll and tilt the vial gently to effect dissolution; do not shake, to avoid foam formation.
- Administration:** IV infusion only
- Method:** **For acute MI:**
Dilute required dose in 100ml infusion fluid and infuse over 60 minutes.
- Compatibility & Stability:** Sodium Chloride 0.9%
Glucose 5%
- Special Notes:**
1. Anaphylactic reactions have been observed.
 2. ECG and BP monitoring recommended.
 3. Complete patient identity card.
 4. Where a high antibody concentration against streptokinase is present, or when recent streptokinase therapy has been given (more than five days and less than one year previously), homolygous fibrinolytics should be given.
