

Co-amoxiclav

Contains a PENICILLIN

Form:	600mg & 1.2g dry powder vial
Reconstitution:	Add 10ml WFI to 600mg vial. Add 20ml WFI to 1.2g vial. Co-amoxiclav should be used within 15 minutes of reconstitution.
Administration Method:	<u>IV Injection</u> Give slowly over 3 - 4 minutes. <u>IV Infusion</u> Add total volume of reconstituted 600mg vial to 50ml infusion fluid. Add total volume of reconstituted 1.2g vial to 100ml infusion fluid. Infuse over 30 - 40 minutes. Solutions for intravenous infusion should be administered in full within 60 minutes of preparation.
Compatibility & Stability:	Sodium Chloride 0.9%
Special Notes:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A transient pink colour may appear during reconstitution in some preparations. Reconstituted solutions are normally colourless or a pale straw colour.
