Form:	100 micrograms per 2ml 500 micrograms per 10ml (supplied to ITUs and Theatres only)
Reconstitution:	Already in solution
Administration Method:	<u>IV Injection</u> No dilution required. Slow IV injection over 1 - 2 minutes. <u>IV Infusion:</u> Refer to ITU/Pharmacy for guidance. <u>IM Injection</u> No dilution required.
Compatibility & Stability:	Sodium Chloride 0.9% Glucose 5%
Special Notes:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Controlled drug.• Monitor blood pressure, heart rate and respiratory rate.• Naloxone should be kept in all areas where opioids are administered.
