

Hyoscine Butylbromide

Form:	20mg per ml ampoule
Reconstitution:	Ready diluted
Administration Method:	<u>IV Injection</u> Give by slow injection over 3 - 5 minutes. May be diluted to a convenient volume with a compatible fluid.
Extravasation	Hyoscine butylbromide has a low pH and may cause venous irritation and tissue damage in cases of extravasation.
Compatibility & Stability:	Sodium Chloride 0.9% Glucose 5%
Special Notes:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Monitor blood pressure and for signs of anaphylaxis.• Patients with underlying cardiac disease such as heart failure, coronary heart disease, cardiac arrhythmia or hypertension should be carefully monitored.• Patients should seek urgent ophthalmological advice if they develop a painful, red eye with loss of vision after administration.
