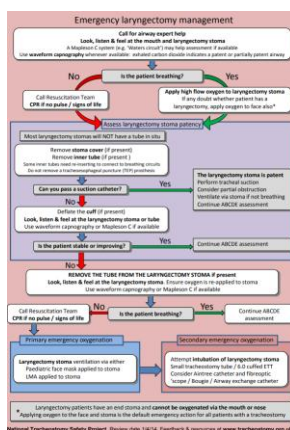
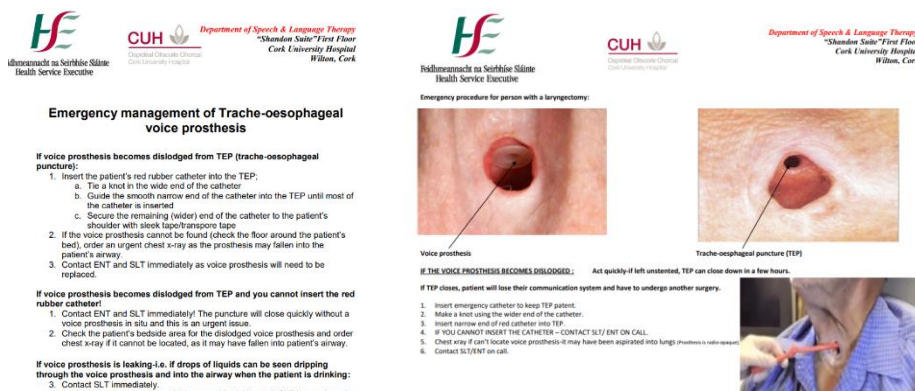
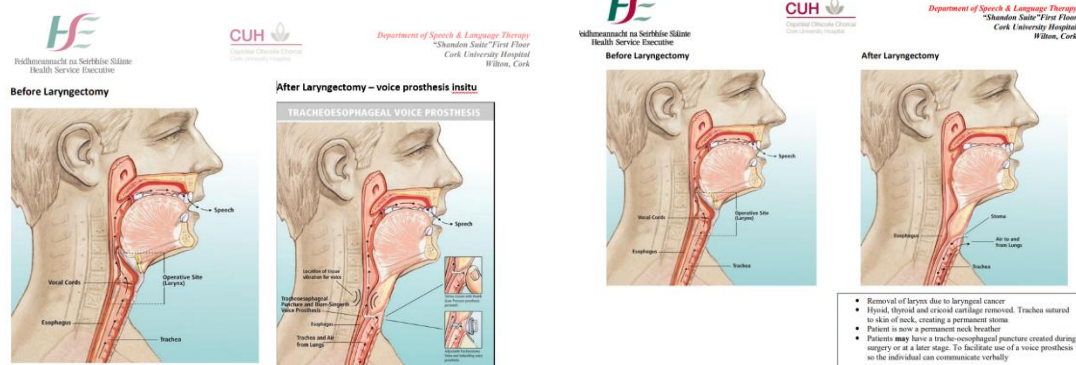


Laryngectomy Supply Box Equipment List
