What we do

- Provide medical assessments for children and adolescents who have experienced sexual assault or where there are concerns regarding possible CSA
- Forensic, acute and non acute medical assessments where there are concerns regarding possible CSA
- Health check, follow up and aftercare

Where are we based?

- Children aged under 14 years are seen at the Family Centre 2 in St. Finbarr's Hospital, South Douglas Road
- Children aged 14 years and above are seen at the Sexual Assault Treatment unit, South Infirmary Victoria University Hospital

How to refer

Monday to Friday 8.30am – 5pm:

Children < 14y – refer to Family centre 2, St. Finbarr's hospital.

Children \geq 14y – refer to SATU, SIVUH

Out of hours and weekends:

Children <14y – refer to Galway CASATS. Contact 091 765751

Children >14y – refer to SATU, SIVUH 24/7

Who to refer

Sexual assault reported to the gardai within forensic timeframe

Recent or historic disclosures/concerns for CSA

Other children identified as being at risk from index case

Where there are concerns for possible CSA – children should be referred to FC2 for consideration of medical examination
