Form	0.5g powder for solution for infusion	Store below 25°C
Reconstitution	Reconstitute each vial with 10mL WFI	
Compatibility & Stability	Sodium chloride 0.9%	
Administration	IV Infusion Add reconstituted solution to 100mL sodium chloride 0.9% Give over 1 hour	
Monitoring	Monitor FBCs regularly, LFTs, renal function. Monitor for skin reactions.	
Additional Information	Pyridoxine can be used for prophylaxis and treatment of isoniazid – induced neuropathy
